



WINES JUST IN

Here we have a selection of new wines to the Dog Inn. They have been chosen to express some of the best wines of Italy. I can particularly recommend the Berengario, an unusual blend of Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon, which is getting an international reputation as a fabulous "Super-Tuscan" style wine without the "Super-price tag" to match! We also have some more recognised wines with some bottle age which are drinking beautifully now. Why not treat yourself and re-examine some old favourites today?!

SPARKLING

Prosecco Rosa (Pink - Italy) **NV Zonin** **£19.95**

A beautiful pink colour with persistent bubbles, the nose is fruity with notes of roses and musk. Fresh and delicate with a delightful finish.

WHITE WINE

Gavi di Gavi (Northern Italy) **2009 Cosetti** **£25.95**

Fruity with notes of green apples, pear and citrus which is followed through on the palate. Elegant and refreshing, made from the Cortese grape variety.

RED WINE

Barbera d'Asti (Piedmont, Italy) **2006 Castello del Poggio** **£23.50**

Made from 100% Barbera grapes, the nose has hints of cherry and an exotic spiciness. The palate is fresh & fruity with an appealing and persistent finish.

Chianti Classico (Tuscany, Italy) **2006 Castello d'Albola** **£28.50**

Charming wine with violets, cherries on the nose which are reflected on the palate. Balanced and structured with precise fruit and a lingering finish.

**Berengario (Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon blend)
(Italy)** **2006 Venezie** **£29.50**

Delicately perfumed with precise fruits and well concentrated. Notes of fruit, liquorice and mint, this is a wine of great elegance and refined.

Barbaresco (Italy) **2006 Poggia La Coste** **£32.50**

Dry and full-bodied, this is a lovely Barbaresco. Rich and velvety on the finish. Delightfully intense wine.

Barolo (Piedmont, Italy) **2005 Poggia La Coste** **£42.50**

Classic and well-balanced with an intense and almost ethereal nose. Complex, it now has some bottle age and is beginning to show its true colours. Fabulous & moreish.
